Show off your creativity by entering the 4-H Pumpkin Contest for October! There will be two categories: carving & non-carving. Entries will be judged on overall appearance, originality, and creativity. No "flame" candles allowed... battery operated or snap light ONLY! 4-H members may enter in both categories.

Carving Contest

- Free hand designs, as well as carving kits & patterns, may be used.
- Finished pumpkins need to be free standing or attached to a foam core or plywood base enabling it to be free standing.

Non-Carving Contest

- Objects, paper and materials of any kind may be used, pinned or glued to the pumpkins.
- You may draw or paint on your entries and/or dress them up.
- No electrical devices may be used.
- Finished pumpkins need to be free standing or attached to a foam core or plywood base enabling it to be free standing.

Each entry needs to have a card tapped or pinned to the pumpkin or base with the 4-H members full name, homeroom teacher, and grade.
